Elementary School Application and Registration Period Under Way

App Mobile Making Stops During Application Period

(Louisville, KY) November 17, 2014—Beginning today, online applications will be accepted for Jefferson County Public School (JCPS) District elementary schools for the 2015-16 school year. The following students should apply during this period:

- Students who are entering kindergarten
- Elementary students who have moved
- Elementary students who want to apply to a magnet school, a magnet program, or Hawthorne Elementary's Dual-Language Spanish Immersion Optional program.

Parents can make choices among the elementary schools in the cluster that serves their address as well as apply to magnet schools, magnet programs, or the optional program at Hawthorne Elementary. Applications are being accepted through **Friday, January 9, 2015**.

Registration and the application **must** be completed online by going to www.jcpsky.net.

- After they register, parents will need to provide proof of address by either taking a document (such as a utility bill, paystub, or government assistance document) with an address on it to the district's registration site located at 4309 Bishop Lane or to any JCPS school, or parents can scan the document and submit it online.
- Once the address is verified, parents can submit an application. Elementary cluster and magnet applications are available online now.
- Parents with a child currently enrolled in a JCPS school can apply online to a magnet school, a magnet program, or Hawthorne Elementary's Dual-Language Spanish Immersion optional program using their Parent Portal identification.

In addition, the JCPS Mobile Online Application Site, or App Mobile, is making stops across the city where parents can register, verify their address, and/or apply using a computer on board.
